## October 15, 2011



In 2011, the ING Hartford Half Marathon will come to West Hartford. 6,000 runners will be on West Hartford roads. These roads will be closed to vehicular traffic during the race. To assist you with your travel plans on October 15th, please see the road closure chart below and the route map on the back of this sheet.

For best access to and from the area enclosed by the race route, we recommend using the Sisson Avenue highway entrances and exits (#46) on I-84.
