

TRAFFIC ALERT



October 12, 2019

More than 10,000 participants will be on the roads of Hartford, West Hartford, South Windsor and East Hartford for the 2019 Eversource Hartford Marathon and Half Marathon. On race day, road closures and travel delays will begin at 7:30 am and will exist throughout the city of Hartford and surrounding towns until 2:00 pm.

To assist with travel plans, race organizers along with local police departments and volunteers will be stationed along the course route to help with foot traffic and spectator questions.

Best access to Hartford Hospital:

From North:

Between 7:00 am – 9:30 am

Take I-91 South to the “Airport Road Exit” Exit 27. Turn right onto Airport Road, turn right onto Ledyard Street, turn left onto Elliot Street, turn right onto Wethersfield Avenue, turn left onto Wyllys Street, continue onto Jefferson Street, turn left onto Seymour Street. At the front of Hartford Hospital, turn right; the entrance to the public garage is on the right immediately past the Medical Office Building and across from Connecticut Children’s Medical Center.

After 9:30 am

From South

Between 7:00 am – 9:30 am

Take I-91 North to the “Airport Road Exit” Exit 27. Turn left onto Brainard Road, turn left onto Airport Road, turn right onto Ledyard Street, turn left onto Elliot Street, turn right onto Wethersfield Avenue, turn left onto Wyllys Street, continue onto Jefferson Street, turn left onto Seymour Street. At the front of Hartford Hospital, turn right; the entrance to the public garage is on the right immediately past the Medical Office Building and across from Connecticut Children’s Medical Center.

From East:

Between 7:00 am – 9:30 am

Take I-84 West to the “Prospect Avenue” Exit 44. Turn right onto Kane Street, turn right onto Prospect Avenue, turn left onto Merrill Street, turn left onto New Park Avenue, turn right onto Hamilton Street, turn left onto Zion Street, turn right onto Ward Street, turn right onto Affleck Street, turn left onto Jefferson Street, turn right onto Seymour St. At the front of Hartford Hospital, turn right; the entrance to the public garage is on the right immediately past the Medical Office Building and across from Connecticut Children’s Medical Center.

After 9:30 am

Take I-84 West to “91 South Main Street” Exit 50. Exit the ramp, turn left onto Market Street, turn left onto Morgan Street S. towards I-91 South. Take “Capitol Area” Exit 29A, move immediately to the right lane and take the first exit (Columbus Boulevard/Convention Center) and turn left crossing the Columbus Boulevard Bridge. Continue through five (5) traffic lights (Columbus Blvd. will curve west and uphill, becoming Wyllys St.). At the fifth traffic light, continue straight, crossing Main St. onto Jefferson Street. At the second traffic light on Jefferson St., turn left onto Seymour St. At the front of Hartford Hospital, turn right; the entrance to the public garage is on the right immediately past the Medical Office Building and across from Connecticut Children’s Medical Center.

From West:

Between 7:00 am – 9:30 am

Take I-84 East to the “Prospect Street” Exit 44. Continue straight onto Caya Avenue, turn right onto Prospect Avenue, turn left onto Merrill Street, turn left onto New Park Avenue, turn right onto Hamilton Street, turn left onto Zion Street, turn right onto Ward Street, turn right onto Affleck Street, turn left onto Jefferson Street, turn right onto Seymour St. At the front of Hartford Hospital, turn right; the entrance to the public garage is on the right immediately past the Medical Office Building and across from Connecticut Children’s Medical Center.
